## How we assessed Open Spaces

Up to now, some open spaces and woodland within the Sturminster Newton Parish have been protected under the North Dorset Local Plan. This was done some time ago and the Neighbourhood Plan has the chance to reassess the open areas in and around the town to determine which should be designated as protected local green spaces, and where the protection may no longer be relevant.

Local green spaces will have the similar protection to green belt. They must be pieces of land that can be shown to be special to all or part of our community and be close to those that benefit. They must have particular local meaning and they cannot be too extensive in area. The factors we can use to identify this are:

- \* Beauty, both looking into the space and out from it
- \* Historical significance
- \* Recreational value level of use
- \* Tranquility
- \* Richness of wildlife
- \* Anything else of local importance.


If an area is designated a local green space this will preclude future development. So it would not make sense to apply this designation to some spaces, such as school playing fields, where ancillary buildings may be needed in the future (though these spaces will be protected as community assets). It also cannot be applied to areas that have been allocated for development. However, on larger sites, plans for new housing should include some new green public space. We have not proposed protection for sites that are adequately covered by other designations, such as Piddles Wood, which is a Site of Special Scientific Interest.

Over 50 open spaces in and around Sturminster have been assessed by the Open Spaces Group and members of the team using the criteria listed above. Some 31 spaces are potentially significant enough to be considered for designation as a local green space.
