Having spent 16 years returning
Our listed house to its former glory, we are
Extremely alarmed to discover you are
proposing to expand the housing development
site south of Bradford St Mary.

Our village has 3 grade 2 listed
buildings in it & ours has the additional ^{STAR} ~~*~~.
It is a statutory requirement to consider
the impact on Heritage Assets - Surely these
houses are just that ?? The village lies
lower than the proposed two sites, so we would
clearly see all the new housing & totally spoil our
views.

I totally understand there is a shortage of

housing about can you prove there has been a Strategic environmental assessment in the total area of Blandford. We cannot be included in 'Blandford' plans as we are ~~very~~ much independent of Blandford.

Apart from the Heritage issue of these proposed sites, there is no evidence that the infrastructure will handle the additional people. We have to wait at least 3 weeks to see a doctor as it is - I know the Little School is full - and following on from that, when the new houses + school were built in Blandford St Mary, there was a pledge that

no horses would ever be built south ^{of} ~~the~~ ^{or outside}
the bypass - Can anyone keep to their
promises? There are more available
sites North + West of Bradford which
are within the bypass.

On a practical point, one Zebra-crossing
going over the A354 for the new population
to get into Bradford, could be a
death trap. Cars, motorbikes + lorries
drive extremely fast around the bypass.
I know, I can hear them!

Please wd you consider all these
points that I have raised. I was born +
bred in Dorset and it is being spoilt,
unwillingly, all too quickly.
