HIGHWAY AUTHORITY RECOMMENDATION

WP/20/00692/DCC Portland Port, Castletown, Portland

With reference to the above planning application and further to the Highway Authority's observation dated 5 August 2021.

It is now understood that the current application does not include any provision for imported limestone dust (from the Island) to be added to ash to make pellets.

The conclusions reached in the Authority's appraisal of the development proposal are still appropriate and the Highway Authority considers that the submitted transport documents are satisfactory and robust. Consequently, that the residual cumulative impact of the development cannot be thought to be "severe", when consideration is given to paragraphs 110 and 111 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF-July 2021) and the Highway Authority has NO OBJECTION subject to the previously recommended conditions.
