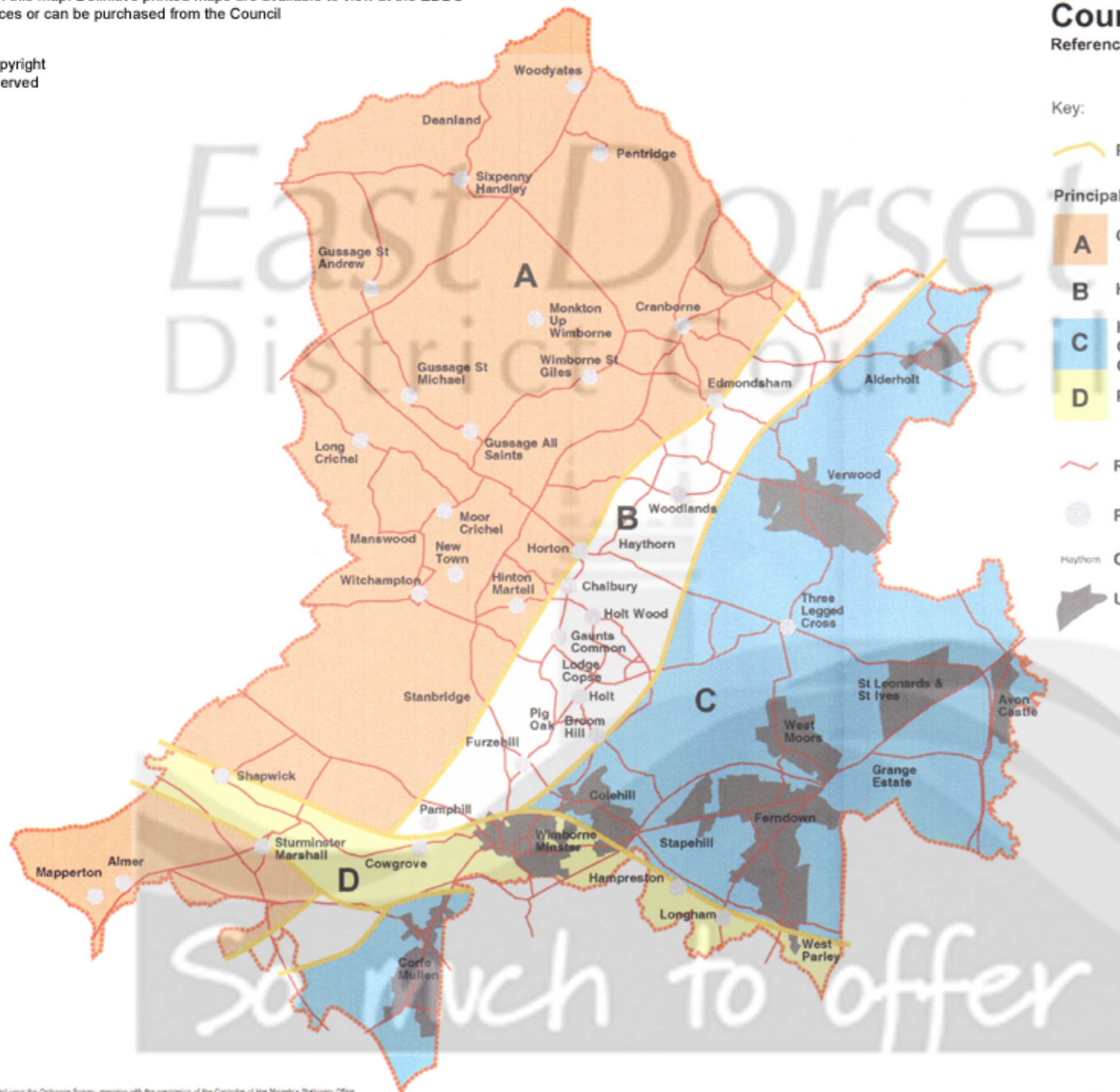
- A** CHALK DOWNLAND { open downland, incised by narrow valleys containing villages; large fields, occasional blocks of woodland becoming more dense on higher land to the north
- B** HILLY CLAY ZONE { acidic clay soils; small fields; woods & copses; settlement concentrated in less hilly southern half
- C** HEATHS, CONIFER PLANTATIONS, OAK WOODS { heaths, conifer plantations, oak woods; urban/suburban areas, especially in south; principal traffic routes
- D** PASTORAL RIVER VALLEY { wide alluvial floodplain; settlements on river terraces
