I am writing further to your email of 8 November 2018 addressed to Mr Kaiserman as the Independent Examiner of the Hazelbury Bryan Neighbourhood Plan. I did forward your email to him but in order to ensure the independence of the examination it would not be appropriate for Mr Kaiserman to enter into any direct correspondence with representors.

As set out in the legislation and PPG, it is expected that the examination of a draft neighbourhood plan will not include a public hearing, and that the examiner should reach a view by considering written representations. In the present case, the Examiner considered hearing sessions to be unnecessary as the consultation responses, including those received on behalf of your client, clearly articulated the objections to the Plan and presented arguments for and against its suitability to proceed to a referendum.

The Examiner has now concluded his examination and his report will shortly be submitted to North Dorset District Council. The Council will make his report publicly available in due course.
