### Safe environment

Dilly Dally's is an ideal and safe environment for those who want to experience social naturism for the first time. Once through the secure gates you enter a world far removed from the feel of the average naturist club. With guests' cars parked in a driveway unseen by passers-by, a solitary door gains entry to an enclosed quadrangle, its central swimming pool surrounded by the other facilities, guests' accommodation and the house itself. In a mixture of semi-detached log cabins and terraced chalets, Dilly Dally's accommodates up to a maximum of 16 guests at a time. All rooms are warm, comfortable, self-contained and en-suite.

The open-sided shelter at the southern end of the complex offers shade in summer. Here there's a dartboard and a free table-football game over which two or four players can get extremely vocal. The cosy perspex-roofed day lounge allows up to a dozen guests to



eat at the tables, sit and read the books or magazines provided, or play a variety of boxed games. Here, too, guests can make unlimited free coffee or tea and there's an honesty box for items from the fridge which contains a choice of canned drinks, bottled water, snacks and individually wrapped filled rolls prepared by Christine for lunch.

Our friends were extremely impressed by their weekend break. We overheard one of them declare Dilly Dally's to be the best winter naturist resort in England. It truly is a special place for a well-deserved holiday, short break or special treats, such as the 58th, 60th and 71st birthdays that were celebrated during our weekend.
