The works at Anchor Paddock have been causing disruption and inconvenience to us for many months.

The continuous flow of heavy construction traffic on Batchelors Lane, including delivery lorries, diggers and dumpers full of gravel, timber and bricks, affects us badly in a number of ways.

1. A significant increase in noise has affected normal activities in our house and garden.

2. Heavy and fast vehicles on the lane have caused severe vibrations within our property.

Batchelors lane has been degraded. The grass verges have been eroded. The lane is now full of deep potholes. Many of the vehicles going to and from Anchor Paddock are driven at high speed, increasing noise and vibration, and raising health and safety hazards for residents, walkers and riders of all ages.
Clouds of dust and stones thrown up by the traffic, cause air pollution affecting breathing and damaging surfaces: windows, hedges and borders, and cars.

If Dorset Planners allows this development, we ask for safe and healthy building and traffic conditions to be attached requiring monitoring, control and repair.
