#### THE DORSET COUNCIL (BARNES WAY, DORCHESTER) (SCHOOL STREET) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (ORDER NO.1) 2024

Dorset Council, having consulted with the chief officer of Dorset Police in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other powers so enabling hereby makes the following order:

### Part 1: Implementation and citation

This Order has been made and shall come into operation on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024 and may be cited as 'The Dorset Council (Barnes Way, Dorchester) (School Street) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Order No.1) 2024.

#### Part 2: Interpretation

In this Order the following expressions shall have the respective meanings assigned to them:

- a) "the 1988 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1988;
- b) "Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in the 1988 Act and includes any part of a vehicle.
- c) "Restricted hours" means the periods between 8.20am until 9.00am and 2.55pm until 3.35pm.
- d) "School Bus" means a vehicle that is adapted or constructed to carry more than 8 passengers and is used in conveying children to and from school during the school term.
- e) "Resident" means a person whose principal home is a dwelling listed in the schedule to this Order;
- f) "post office" and any reference to "post office vehicle" or "postal packets" shall be construed in the context of the Postal Services Act 2000 and any amendment to that Act.
- g) "household" any premises located within the description of schedule 1 to this Order.
- h) "goods" includes goods or burden of any description,
- i) "goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods, or a trailer so constructed or adapted

#### Part 3: Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Save as provided in Part 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle during the restricted hours to enter into or proceed on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

## Part 5. Exemptions

Nothing in this Order shall apply to a vehicle in the following circumstances:

- a) The vehicle is directed by or with the permission of a Police Officer or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform.
- b) The vehicle is being used for emergency services purposes.
- c) The vehicle is in the service of Dorset Council being necessarily used in connection with highway maintenance, parking enforcement, waste collection or street cleansing activities in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
- d) The vehicle is being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
- e) The vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
- f) The vehicle is being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic.
- g) School bus requiring access or egress.
- h) for the convenience of residents of premises adjacent to the length of road specified in the schedule to this order on any occasion for the removal of furniture from any household to another place
- i) is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of goods or persons at any household situated on, or adjacent to, the length of road specified in the schedule to this order.
- a vehicle to be used in the service of the Post Office for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000 (as amended).

Barnes Way, Dorchester	From its junction with Rothesay Road in an easterly direction for approximately 124 metres.	8.20am until 9.00am 2.55pm until 3.35pm
