The above Order made on 10 December 2002, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a footpath running from its junction with Footpath 17, Cattistock at the parish boundary at the river at approximate National Grid Reference ST 56440203 south westerly to its junction with the classified road C38 at approximate National Grid Reference ST 56440200, a distance of approximately 45 metres.

Any letters received will be made available for public inspection.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Dorset County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Department of the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
