With regard to the proposed modifications to the above Order, Dorset Council submitted all the available evidence with the original Statement of Case on 21 December 2021. No further evidence has come to light. There is nothing in the Inspector's Interim Order Decision to suggest that she has misinterpreted any of our arguments, however she has determined that the evidence in relation to the section of the route between points E and F on the order plan is not adequate. We do not have any additional evidence which we consider will change the Inspector's decision.

The OMA stands by its original Statement of Case and has no further comment to make at this time.
